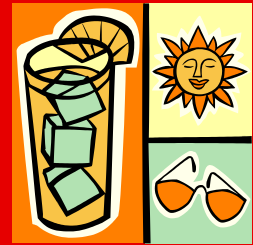

**AUGUST, 2012****Council Highlights**

**These are some of the resolutions made at the July 18, 2012 regular council meeting of the Village of Heisler Council:**

- Revise Policy #1211– Land Sale agreement for Lots Requiring Development Policy to remove the \$1000.00 deposit and add a 2% (of total estimated cost) refundable development deposit for all new developments.
- Accept the Mutual Aid Fire Services Agreement with Forestburg
- Submit an application to the Community Infrastructure Improvement grant for funding for the new playground.
- Forward payment to Forestburg Transit Mix for the completion of the sewer upgrade project between Rutherford and Aberhart Ave. in the amount of \$170,955.23 including GST.
- Instruct Interim CAO to contact ATCO Electric and D-2 Electric to begin the new municipal park lighting project.
- Accept the resignation of Sarah Clausen, 2012 STEP Student
- Accept employee agreement with Cashton MacAhonic, 2012 STEP student for the remainder of the summer.

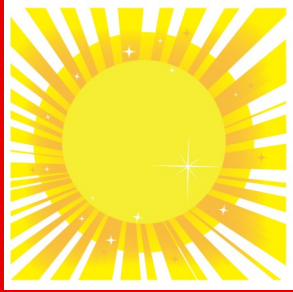

**REMINDER....**Property Taxes were due on July 31st, 2012. Thank-you to all who paid their taxes on time. If your taxes have not been paid, a 12% penalty was added to your tax roll on August 3, 2012. If the 2012 property taxes are not paid by December 31st, 2012... a 16% penalty will be added to your tax roll. To avoid penalties, please drop by the office or mail your payment. We accept cash or cheque. We also have a 24 hour mail slot (no cash please) for you to drop your payment. Utilities were due July 31st, a 4% penalty has been added on to the accounts that were not paid on or before that date.

### ALLIED PAPER RECYCLING BIN LOCATIONS

- Town of Daysland– Located at the town recycling centre by the town shop
- Village of Forestburg– Located at the town recycling centre by the town shop
- Town of Killam– Located at the town recycling centre by the town shop
- Town of Sedgewick– Located at the town recycling depot by the Rec Centre
- Town of Hardisty– Located at the town recycling centre by the town shop
- Main Landfill– Located 6 1/2 miles north of Hwy 13 on RRD 122

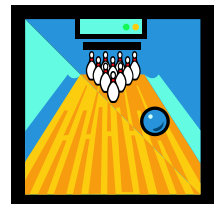
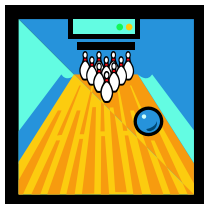

## GREAT NEWS FOR EVERYONE!!

**Night's Alive** is coming alive but we need your help, we are a new organization funded by Flagstaff County. Nights Alive will serve youth ages 12 to 17, and provide them a safe environment to socialize and interact with other youth their age in the communities of Flagstaff.

We need your support, by encouraging youth to come to the centre and parents occasionally to volunteer in the concession area. There will be games available like air hockey, foosball, pool table, table tennis, arcade games, an art/theatre room, XBOX kinect, Wii plus a quiet room where kids can work on school projects together or just do homework. A concession for snacks, drinks, popcorn etc. will be available at a minimal cost. We will be planning other events throughout communities in the region in the future. We are planning to have speakers come in to share their hobbies, i.e. photography, Tae Kwon Do, crafts, painting, etc. Our main goal is to let the youth have a place to call home in a controlled environment within their community.

Our youth are our future and to sustain a community we need to keep our youth in the community and have them be proud of it and be part of it. The concept of "It takes a community to raise a child" has been lost. There are a lot of children that never get the opportunity to play some of the games that will be offered at the centre or get involved in team sports i.e. hockey, 4-H, baseball etc. due to the cost.

When youth have something to do it alleviates trouble.

We will be located at 4902—50 Street (the old county building) Sedgewick, Alberta. In the future it is planned to have some sort of transportation system to pick up youth from different communities, bring them to the centre and home again or from Sedgewick to another community. We will also be offering events in other communities, i.e. pool party in Killam, curling in Lougheed, outdoor pool in Forestburg, Hardisty Rodeo for the day etc. We are open to ideas!!
