Advising patrons on their next great read is one of the most important services libraries can provide. Readers' advisory (RA) is the art of matching up patrons with books they might like to read based on what they have enjoyed reading in the past. One of the best means to provide successful RA is to read widely yourself.

However, that isn't always possible and there are a variety of print and online tools that staff can use to assist with RA services.

Parkland subscribes to the following online readers' advisory tools:

Fiction Connection

Novelist

These two databases are accessible to staff and patrons from any internet computer on the Services> <u>eLibrary</u> web page or through the *eLibrary* tab in the PRL <u>catalogue</u>.

<u>Whichbook</u> provides a unique interface to finding new reads using sliding scales of story characteristics, such as safe vs disturbing, easy vs demanding, or even short vs long.
