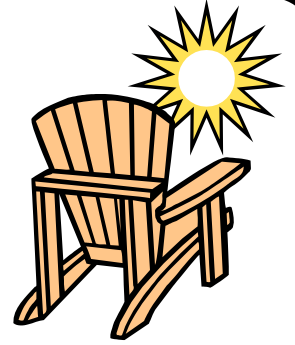

Note from the Administration Office....

Property Taxes were due on July 31st, 2014. Thank-you to all who paid their taxes on time. If your taxes have not been paid, a 12% penalty on the current balance has been added to your tax roll. If entire balance owing for 2014 property taxes is not paid by December 31st, 2014... a 16% penalty will be added to your tax roll ~pursuant to the Unpaid Taxes Bylaw #451-11. We accept cash or cheque, or you may pay online and at your bank (ATB, Credit Unions, BMO, CIBC ~Please include your acct # when making a payment) We also have a 24 hour mail slot at the village office (no cash please) for you to drop your payment.

Utilities were due July 31st, a 4% penalty has been added on to the accounts that were not paid on or before.

Advising patrons on their next great read is one of the most important services libraries can provide. Readers' advisory (RA) is the art of matching up patrons with books they might like to read based on what they have enjoyed reading in the past. One of the best means to provide successful RA is to read widely yourself. However, that isn't always possible and there are a variety of print and online tools that staff can use to assist with RA services.

- **TREES AND BRANCHES**
- Wood
- Meat, bones and fatty food waste
- Pet Waste
- Diseased Plants
- Green Weeds

The **compost site** is located just north of the railway tracks, directly across the highway from Main Street.

Heisler Garbage Transfer Site is located off of Manning Ave, turn south (in between Main Street and Sifton Street).
