Note from the Administration Office....

Property Taxes were due on July 31st, 2015. Thank-you to all who paid their taxes on time. If your taxes have not been paid, a 12% penalty on the current balance has been added to your tax roll. If a balance remains owing for 2015 property taxes on December 31st, 2015... a 16% penalty will be added to your tax roll ~pursuant to the Unpaid Taxes Bylaw #451-11.

We accept cash or cheque, or you may pay online and at your bank (ATB, Credit Unions, BMO, CIBC ~Please include your acct # when making a payment) We also have a 24 hour mail slot at the village office (no cash please) for you to drop your payment.

Utilities were due July 30th, a 4% penalty has been added on to the accounts that were not paid on or before.

Public library network support

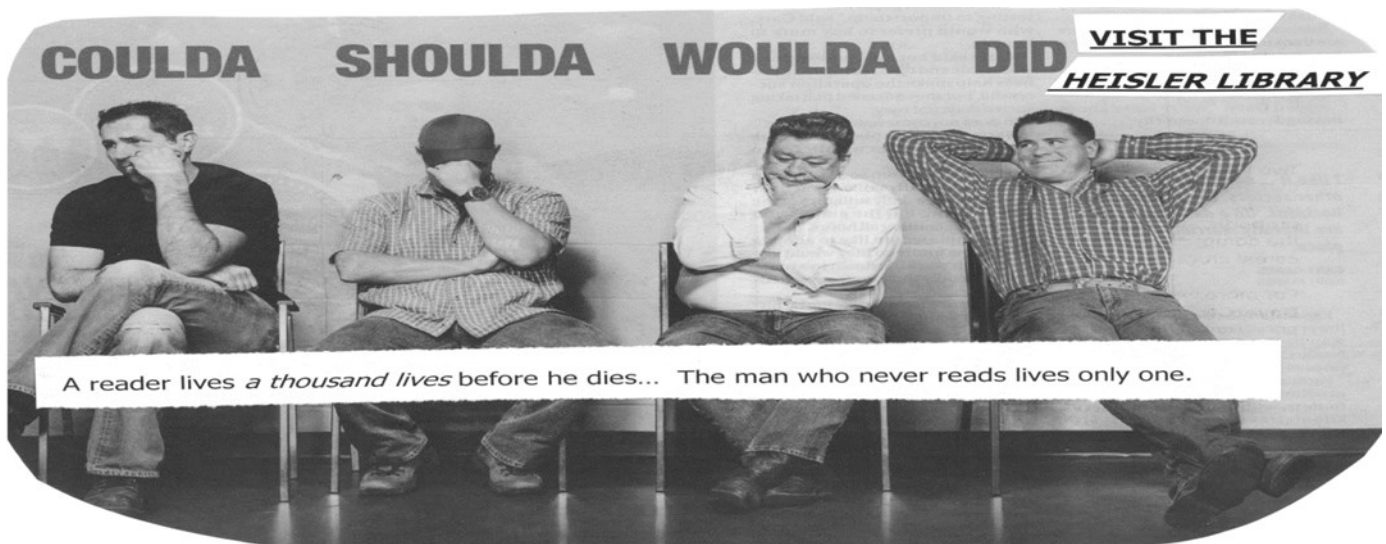
The provincial government also provides network support to enable province-wide sharing of public library resources. Public library network support provided by PLSB totalled nearly \$4,900,000 in 2014-2015 and these numbers are forecasted to be consistent for 2015-2016.

This support in 2014/2015 included:

- \$2,600,000 for SuperNet connectivity for all Alberta public libraries participating in the Public Library Network
 - \$750,000 to cover the cost of interlibrary loan delivery via Government Courier
 - \$250,000 to The Alberta Library to facilitate access to resources from the academic library sector
 - \$150,000 to Chinook Arch Library Board for service to broker province-wide, national and international interlibrary loans from all types of libraries
- \$800,000 for public library access to a variety of electronic resources including Hoopla, Zinio, Press Reader and Mango language-learning software

Total Provincial Support

In 2015/2016, total provincial support for public library service (as provided by PLSB) is budgeted at \$36,000,000 (subject to Legislative approval)

TIPS (Teaching Independent Parent Support) - promotes independence, parenting skills and good nutrition for pregnant women and families with pre-school children through home visitation, group activities and supporting connections within communities.
PCAP (Parent Child Assistance Program) - services women who abuse drugs/alcohol during pregnancy, and are pregnant or 6 months post-partum and women who have a child diagnosed with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder and are currently abusing alcohol/drugs. Trained and supervised Parent Mentors provide home visitation and intervention for 3 years.

- Kidsport (grants to children from families facing financial barriers so they can participate in registered sporting programs) Contact Laura Yakivchuk-Arredt 780-801-0821 or VBFCSS at 780-336-4024 - Beaver
- For Families experiencing financial hardship, subsidy is available through Flagstaff Family & Community Services for assistance with activity fees, such as sporting events, dance, etc. A letter of request can be emailed to the Director, Lynne Jenkinson at ljenkinson@telus.net or by calling 385-3976.
- Children's Services has a subsidy for playschool families to access called "Stay at Home Parent" and it can be accessed if the playschool is a licensed facility.
