Note from the Administration Office....

Property Taxes were due on July 31st, 2017. Thank-you to all who paid their taxes on time. If your taxes have not been paid, a 12% penalty on the current balance has been added to your tax roll. If a balance remains owing after December 31, 2017... a 16% penalty will be added to your tax roll ~pursuant to the Unpaid Taxes Bylaw #451-11.

We accept cash or cheque, or you may pay online and at your bank (ATB, Credit Unions, BMO, CIBC ~Please include your acct/roll # when making a payment) We also have a 24 hour mail slot at the village office (no cash please) for you to drop your payment.

Utilities were due July 31st, a 4% penalty has been added to the accounts that were not paid on or before.

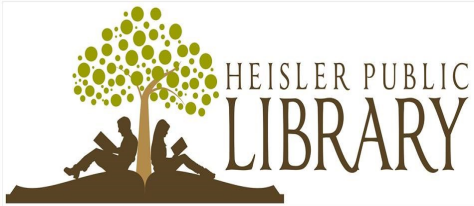
