Council Highlights

These are some of the resolutions made at the November 14, 2012 regular council meeting of the Village of Heisler Council:

- To approve Policy #1902- Leaves of Absence Policy
 - To approve the revision of Policy #1003- Travel, Subsistence & Honorarium Policy
 - To instruct Interim CAO to write a letter to the County of Flagstaff to inform them that Council has accepted the call-out rate for Heisler's fire truck
 - To appoint Calvin MacAhonic, Public Works Foreman as the Village of Heisler Development Officer
 - To approve the Flagstaff Family & Community Services 2013 Budget, Heisler's requisition in 2013 will be **\$1,132.50 (\$7.50 per capita)**
 - To approve the Flagstaff Intermunicipal Partnership 2013 Proposed budget, Heisler's requisition for 2013 will be **\$442.24**
 - To transfer the remaining funds of **\$3,627.00** from Community Hall Insurance to Recreation Reserves for 2013
 - To transfer MSI Capital funds of **\$90,000** into Capital Reserves

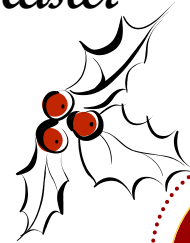

Dog Control Bylaw #468-12

Reminder:

Citizens are reminded that dog tags are required for all dogs in the Village of Heisler for a fee. Tags allow Village staff to find the owner quickly and efficiently. If your pet is found without an identification tag, the animal will be sent to the Forestburg Vet Clinic and the owner will be subject to a fine.

Dog tags are DUE BY: JANUARY 31/13

After January 31, 2013: \$30.00
Restricted dog license: \$100.00
After January 31, 2013: \$200.00
Replacement tags: \$5.00**

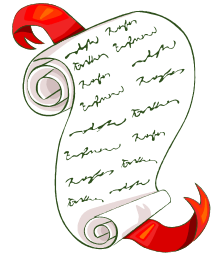

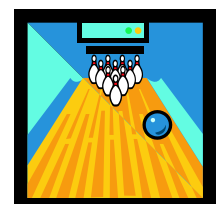
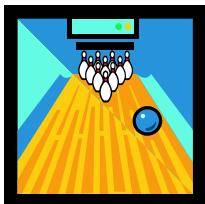
