### Council Highlights

2013

These are some of the resolutions made at the November 21, 2013 regular council meeting of the Village of Heisler Council:

- To pass Bylaw #482-13, the Borrowing Bylaw. A bylaw to authorize the financing and interim borrowing of certain sums of money for operating expenditures, not to exceed \$2,000.
- To accept the Bylaw Enforcement Contract with Daryl Reinke from November 21, 2013 to December 31, 2014.
- To send a letter of support for the Killam Recreation Board for their initiative of having their bowling alley converted into a regional fitness centre.
- To place an ad in Kijiji to advertise the sale of the 1979 GMC fire truck for \$20,000.
- To store the grader in the fire hall and put the new wildland brush truck into the public works shop until a decision is made for a permanent storage solution for the grader.
- To pay the CAO's travel expenses of \$173.00 for November, 2013.
- To approve the Flagstaff Family and Community Services 2014 budget as presented. Heisler's 2014 requisition will be \$1,132.50.



1992. During the first few years, the library was managed and operated entirely on a volunteer basis. The Heisler Municipal Library and Archives continued to be housed in the same building until April 1, 2002. At this time, due to high operational costs and the condition of the building, the library was moved to its present location in the post office building. The grand opening at this location was held on May 24, 2002.

The first paid library manager was hired in February of 1994. At present the board employs two library managers. The present board consists of a chairperson and four other members.
