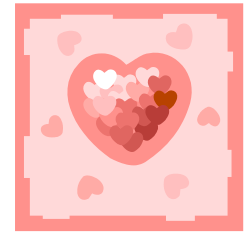

# Council Highlights

**These are some of the resolutions made at the January 23, 2013 regular council meeting of the Village of Heisler Council:**

- To approve Bylaw #477-13, Municipal Historic Resource Designation Bylaw
- To accept the Compensation Agreement with 1689492 Alberta INC.
- To accept quote #1 from Associated Engineering to facilitate Heisler's drinking water safety plan. \$11,980 plus GST will be split between 10 municipalities
- To pass the 2013 Village of Heisler Capital/Operating Budget
- To transfer \$2,500 into fire reserves for a new furnace for the fire hall, funds were established in 2012
- To transfer \$2,641.20 into recreation reserves for future recreation/parks projects, funds were established in 2012
- To accept the employment agreement with Public Works Foreman, Calvin MacAhonic
- To not approve a recommendation from the Flagstaff Intermunicipal Partnership Committee that a grant application be submitted to Alberta Municipal Affairs through the Regional Collaboration Program for exploring regional municipal service Delivery

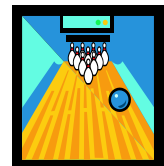
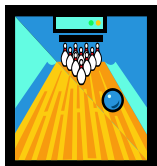

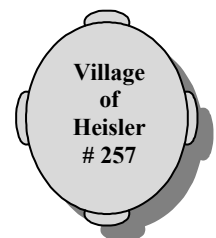
**Reminder:**

**Restricted dog license: \$100.00**
