## Council Highlights

### These are some of the resolutions made at the January 14, 2014 regular council meeting of the Village of Heisler Council:

- To lower the water consumption allowance from 25m<sup>3</sup> per month to 20m<sup>3</sup> per month for all water accounts. Council implements a base rate infrastructure fee of \$12.50 per month for each water and sewer closed utility accounts. The changes will be written into the Water, Sewer and Waste Bylaw and will come into effect on March 1, 2014.
- To amend the Fees and Charges Bylaw to remove the word "occupied" for residential and commercial properties garbage fees. Closed accounts will be charged garbage fees starting March 1, 2014.
- To amend Policy #1211—Lots Requiring Development. Purchasers will be required to pay a \$5,000 deposit to the Village upon purchase of a lot. The payment will be a damage deposit that will be returned to the purchaser when the development is complete.
- To accept the proposal from Xerox for the lease of a new copier for the admin office.
- To renew the Community Peace Officers agreement for one year at \$134.00 per month.
- To approve the Flagstaff Intermunicipal Partnership budget of \$59,330 and to approve the proposal from Forestburg to take on the role of the FIP managing partner.
- To transfer \$11,552.00 of 2013 budgeted funds into fire reserves for future fire department operation.

FIRST STEP: Create two accounts

- Go to the Parkland Zinio site at [www.rbdigital.com/parklandab/service/zinio/landing](http://www.rbdigital.com/parklandab/service/zinio/landing) (or follow the Zinio link from [www.prl.ab.ca/elibrary](http://www.prl.ab.ca/elibrary)).
- Click on the Checkout Now link for any title.
- Click on Create a free account and enter your information. You will be automatically logged in.
- Click on Checkout Now again, and you will be taken to the main Zinio website ([ca.zinio.com](http://ca.zinio.com)).
- You will be prompted to create a second account. Use the same information you used for the first account (you especially need to use the same email address).
- You're done! You can now view the magazine on a computer or in the Zinio app.

Setting up the Zinio app (available for Apple, Android, PlayBook)

Note: Create your two Zinio accounts FIRST (see left).

- Install the Zinio app from the app store.
- Open the Zinio app.
- Tap on the Settings button. On an Apple device, this is the icon of a gear at the bottom of the screen. On an Android device, tap on the top right menu button, then tap on Settings.
- Tap on Sign In.
- Enter your account information and tap on Sign In. You only need to do this once – then it will log you in automatically when you load the app.
- Exit the app's settings:
  - o On an Apple device: Tap on the X to close the Settings screen. If the app itself closes, reopen it..
  - o On an Android device: Tap on the Back button or on Settings at the top of the screen to get out of the app's Settings.
- Tap on the Read button to view magazines you have checked out. This button will be at the top or bottom of your screen.
