- To renew the contact for assessment services with Wainwright Assessment Group at a cost in 2014 of \$3,600 plus GST
- To approve the Heisler staff Christmas gift budget of \$300.00
- To accept the 2014 quote for software and support from Neptune Technology Group for \$2,604.00 including GST
- To accept the 2014 support agreement with Muniware for \$252.92 per month plus GST
- To approve final payment to Fort Garry Fire Trucks for \$143,037.30 including GST for the 2013 Freightliner fire truck

- To approve the Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste 2014 proposed budget, Heisler's requisition is \$22,124.05

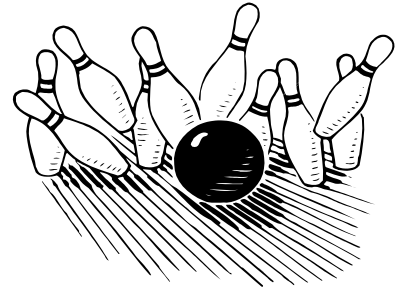

Dog Control Bylaw #468-12

Friendly Reminder:

Citizens are reminded that dog tags are required for all dogs in the Village of Heisler for a fee. Tags allow Village staff to find the owner quickly and efficiently. If your pet is found without an identification tag, the animal will be sent to the Forestburg Vet Clinic and the owner will be subject to a fine.

Regular dog license: \$15.00
After January 31, 2014: \$30.00
Restricted dog license: \$100.00
After January 31, 2014: \$200.00
Replacement tags: \$5.00

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

Excerpts from Village of Heisler's Snow Removal Bylaw #459-11.

PART II: OWNER, OCCUPANT AND/OR PERSON(S) OBLIGATIONS

3. All owners of property shall be responsible for removal from their sidewalk any snow, ice, dirt, debris or other material.

3.1 Every occupant or owner of any property, other than a residential property shall within twenty-four (24) hours (excluding Sundays and holidays) after the cessation of a snowfall, remove all snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to said property.

3.2 Every occupant or owner of any residential property shall within seventy-two (72) hours (excluding Sundays and holidays) after the cessation of a snowfall, remove all snow and ice from any sidewalk adjacent to the said property.

3.3 No people shall deposit or in any way cause to be deposited upon any public sidewalk, roadway or street, any snow or ice or dirt.

3.4 Notwithstanding Section 3.3 of this Bylaw, snow and ice from public sidewalks may be deposited onto the adjacent street if done so within twenty-four (24) hours of cessation of snowfall, and/or if the street has not yet been cleared.

3.5 No person shall deposit or in any way causes to be deposited any snow or ice upon any drainage ditch culvert end or catch basin.

3.6 No person shall deposit or in any way cause to be deposited any snow or ice on any fire hydrant or on the area adjacent to a fire hydrant which in any way blocks access to, or prevents operation of, or restricts the visibility of the hydrant.

3.7 No person shall cause damage to any sidewalk by pounding, hammering, picking or chiseling or depositing any chemical or other substance thereon.

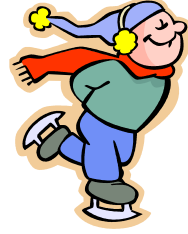
Please DO NOT shovel, plow or blow snow from private driveways onto public roadways or private property other than your own.

You could be fined if you are found to be in contravention of this bylaw.
