Reminder Dog Tag Fees Are Due

Dog owners are required to pay yearly for their dog tags. The purpose of dog tags are so if your beloved dog gets out and is lost the village can properly identify the dog and who the owners are so they can be returned safely. If your pet is found without an identification tag it will be brought to the Sedgewick Vet Clinic and the owner will be subject to a fine per Dog Control Bylaw #468-12





VILLAGE OF HEISLER 2025 Utility Rate Change Information

Dear Residents,

At the November 28, 2024 regular council meeting, Heisler Council reviewed and discussed the current utility rates and decided to increase the utility rates to cover the essential costs of operating the village's water and wastewater systems, including infrastructure improvements, utility emergency response (leaks and ruptures), and system maintenance.

Transition Plan

To implement the total cost recovery, the village would need to increase the rates by 34.94% due to the overall economical cost increase over the last years. The village tried to keep the cost and the utility rates as low as possible for a long time, however, due to rising inflation, and to ensure the sustainability of our village we must meet these demands.

Understanding that this rate change can significantly affect household budgets, we are implementing a phased approach to ease the transition. This plan means that the first year (2025) of implementation is meant to align the rates increase of 17.47%, with the move toward full cost recovery in the second year (2026) after an additional review by Heisler Council. Following the transition period, utility rates will be reviewed and adjusted annually to keep up with the actual costs of all services to our residents. Village Council and Staff will assure you, that we will monitor and review economic change to keep it to a minimum impact for our residents.

Thank you for your understanding regarding this matter.


