Any unpaid current taxes after that date will be levied interest at 12%. Unpaid taxes after December 31, 2013 will be levied interest of 16% on the total balance owing.

***Date changed to July 1st, from June 1st**

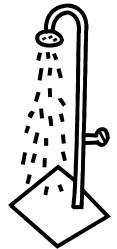
The Village of Heisler has dropped the water consumption allowance from 35m³ to 25m³ per month for all properties.

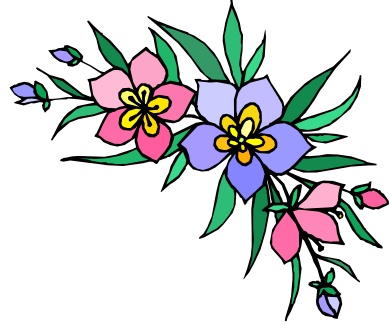

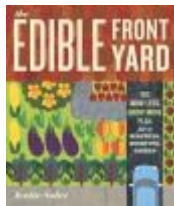
The Alberta Library (TAL) Card

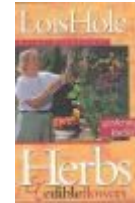

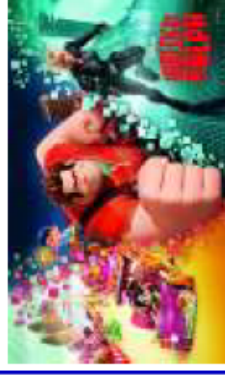
