- To approve the CAO travel expenses of \$455 from February 28 to May 31, 2017

- To accept the June 6, 2017 resignation of Village of Heisler council member, Kelvin Tetz as information. Council appointed Dennis Steil as the Chief Elected Official, with Morgan Doege as the Deputy Mayor
- To approve a request for a variance of a portion clause 3.2 of the Land Sale Agreement for Lots Requiring Development for the sale of lots 4&5, block 2, plan 1810 B.Q.

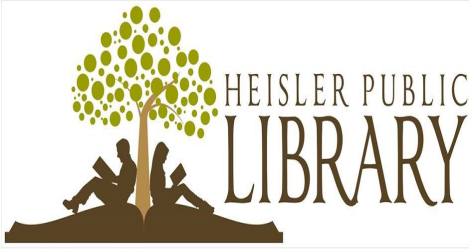
