These are some of the resolutions passed at the June 13, 2019 Regular Council Meeting:

- To advice CAO to check with Ducks Unlimited if the ditch next to a residents house at the south end of the Village is protected, and if there is a possibility to pump out the water and also to look into a solution with Public Works to solve the problem.
- To approve the Flagstaff Regional Fire Services Business and Implementation Plan and to join the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society.
- To approve the Intermunicipal Assessment Review Board Agreement.
- To direct CAO to draft a letter under Mayor Wood's signature advising the Flagstaff
- Intermunicipal Partnership Committee that the Village is **not** willing to act as the Managing Partner.
- To direct CAO to draft a letter under Mayor Wood's signature advising the Flagstaff
- Intermunicipal Partnership Committee that the Village is committed to continuing to support by way of membership for an additional 5 years.
- To approve the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision & Development Appeal Board Agreement.
- To accept the quote in the amount of \$1,977.95 plus GST and \$124.80 for the permit for the power upgrade at the small Campground and that costs will be paid from the money left on the Campground MSI Grant.
- To approve to balance the costs for the sidewalk repair Motion 734-19 from April 16, 2019
- regular Council meeting with the on June 5, 2019 matured GIC and to reinvest \$21,000.00 into a 1 year cashable GIC.

The next regular council meeting: July 29, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.
