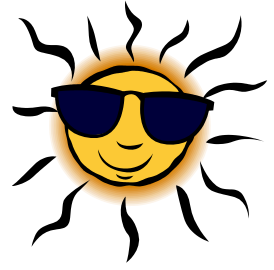

2013 ASSESSMENT & TAXATION NOTICES

Village of Heisler in the Province of Alberta

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 311 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 that the Village of Heisler has mailed combined Assessment and Taxation Notices to all persons appearing on the Assessment Roll as of May 31, 2013.

Any person who desires to object to the entry of his/her name or that of any other person upon the said roll or to the assessment value placed upon any property, must lodge his/her complaint(s) in writing on a form available online and/or at the Village Office and submit to the Clerk of the Assessment Review Board on or before July 30, 2013

A charge of **\$50.00** is required for each residential assessment appeal and the maximum Assessment Review Board fee is required for commercial assessment. The fee is refundable if the Assessment Review Board makes a decision in favour of the complainant pursuant to Section 481(2) of the Municipal Government Act.

Assessment complaints, with applicable fee, can be forwarded to the Clerk of the Assessment Review Board, c/o the Village of Heisler, Box 60, Heisler, Alberta T0B 2A0.

All assessed persons are deemed to have received their notices as a result of this publication.

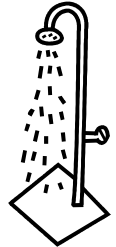
REMINDER to RESIDENTS:
