Viability Review Request—Information Update

October 21/16 - The village was informed by letter that a petition requesting a viability review of Heisler was submitted to Municipal Affairs on October 14/16.

November 23/16 - The village was informed by letter that the petition was reviewed by Municipal Affairs and determined to be sufficient.

January 23/17 - Municipal Affairs staff attended the village to conduct viability screening interviews with council, administration, and petitioner representative(s).

March 30/17 - The village received a letter dated Mar 24/17 from Municipal Affairs to inform that the screening did not uncover urgent viability issues that would warrant conducting a viability review at this time. They have decided to evaluate the outcome of the FIP Regional Governance initiative first, and depending on the outcome, may revisit undertaking a viability review in the near future.



Users are reminded that there is a compost bin at the recycling station for yard waste only. Composters are encouraged to make use of the bin.


NOTICE - Community Compost Bins April 1st


