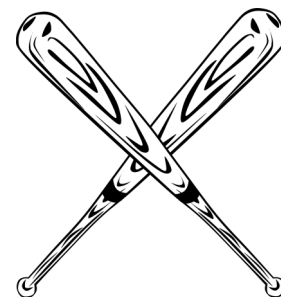

- That remuneration will be at \$100.00 for all Council meetings in or out of town, plus receipts. Mileage paid will be at \$0.55 per kilometer.

- That Council gives all three reading to Bylaw #554-24 Off-Leash Dog Area.
- That Council reviews, approves and adopts Policy HS-007 Code of Conduct Policy for Residents and Members of the Public; including ban waved for elections and public hearings.

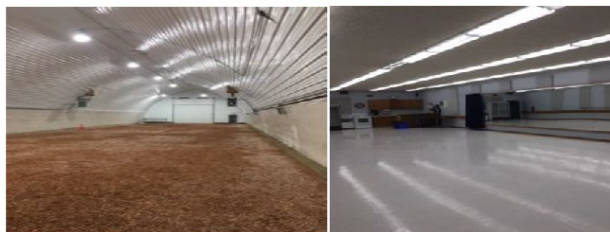
