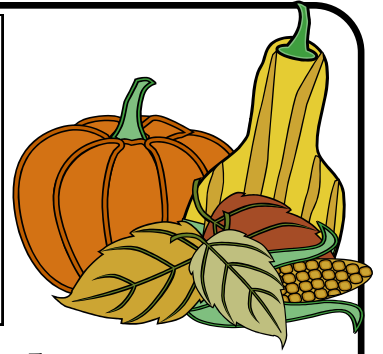

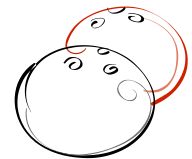
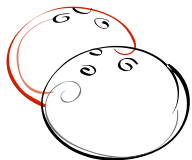

## HEISLER PUBLIC LIBRARY—OCTOBER NEWS

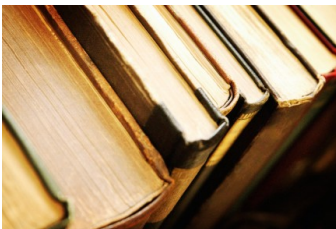

Books/audio/video items requested from other libraries will carry that libraries fines when returned late, so please renew them on-line or at our library. The lending period is 3 weeks.



We have added many new (donated) books to our shelves. Thank you to the people who have been so thoughtful. Some of the titles and authors are: The Canadian Hockey Atlas/Cole, The Maze Runner series/Dashner, The 100-Year-Old Man Who Climbed Out the Window and Disappeared/Jonasson, Rebel Angels/Bray, A Great and Terrible Beauty/Bray, 1,000 Placed to See Before You Die, Private/J. Patterson, Drums of Autumn/D. Gabaldon and several Sue Grafton novels. This is only a start of many great books to read before winter sets in. The County Kit Book Exchange has again placed over 200 children books on our shelves for young readers. 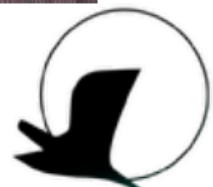

In addition to his grief support groups, Dr. Bill conducts many professional seminars and educational programs on the topics of grief both in North America and in Britain. He has published eight books at last count, and has a 3 DVD series entitled ‘**Grief Matters**’ He has developed a Training Programme on “How to Organize and Facilitate Community Grief Support Groups”, and a very innovative website at [www.griefjourney.com](http://www.griefjourney.com). He has recently developed a brand new concept in grief support on a web portal and is pioneering a new concept in bringing grief support to a new generation on Facebook.
