## Heisler Public Library Gets a Bright New Look

A quiet transformation took place at the Heisler Public Library over the past year. It was once divided into two rather cozy rooms with very little natural light. Last fall the Heisler Library Board, chaired by Val Volk and Library Managers Dixie Wolbeck and Marvis Zimmer decided that it was time for a change and took steps to make it happen. The whole team, aided by Nicholas Howell, rolled up their sleeves to box up the collection for storage in a shed next to the library. Renovations took place over 4 weeks, when the library was semi-closed.

Changes to the library include removing the wall separating the two rooms to create a larger space. To let in as much natural light as possible, a steel door with a window was added at the back of the library. Other updates include new light fixtures, paint throughout, and fantastic new flooring. Steel shelving was obtained from the Stettler Public Library with team members again rolling up their sleeves to transport the shelving and set it up

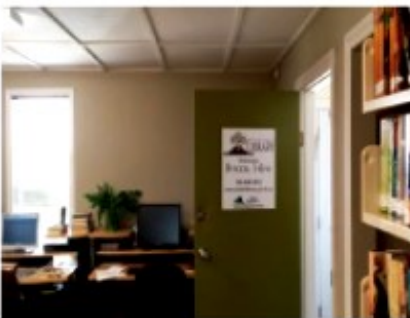
in its new home! A new table with chairs provides a comfortable space for people to do research or use the computers.

The library renovation coincides with the launch of Heisler's new logo, developed by board member Karen Wolbeck. Karen also contributed her time to add word designs to the walls, one stating "A reader lives a thousand lives before he dies... the man who never reads lives only one". The new logo is highlighted on signs posted outside the library and on the inside door, creating a welcoming visual that lets visitors know they have come to the right place. "The library is such a bright, welcoming space now. All of our members have been very vocal in letting us know the changes are outstanding and appreciated" said Dixie Wolbeck, Library Manager. Congratulations to the Village of Heisler on your beautiful new space!
