NOMINATION DAY - Monday September 18, 2017

Eligibility: You are eligible for nomination if you meet ALL of the following criteria:

- 18 years of age on or before Nomination Day
- Canadian citizen
- Must have lived in the Village of Heisler for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding Election Day
- Are not otherwise ineligible or disqualified
- ~Nomination forms must be delivered to the Village of Heisler administration office in person.

Please note that and Official Notice of Nomination Day will be mailed to each residence September 11/17.

ELECTION DAY - Monday October 16, 2017

Eligibility – You are eligible to vote if you meet ALL of the following criteria:

- 18 years of age
- Canadian citizen
- Lived in Alberta for 6 consecutive months immediately preceding Election Day
- Resident of the Village of Heisler
- Provided the required proof of eligibility as required by Section 53 of the Local Authorities Election Act.


